Minimum CAP for Graduation

In order to graduate, an undergraduate student must have a minimum CAP of 2.0 and must have completed the University's requirements on the reading of modules required for the award of each degree.

EXAMINABLE ENRICHMENT COURSES

Courses coded "XO" are optional enrichment course graded **Pass with Distinction (PD)** or **Pass (P)**. They are not included in the calculation of the CAP.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Only leave of absence of one semester or longer is recorded in the transcript.

SPECIAL TERM

Special Term is offered in two parts i.e. Part 1 and Part 2. Students are able to study in either parts or both.
